BAPTISM "Unless you are born again..."

Arrangements can be made with the parish priest. Parents should be registered in our parish. Baptismal classes are held for parents the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM - only when needed. Call the rectory one week in advance.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY "What God has joined..."

Engaged couples should phone the rectory to make an appointment with the parish priest to set the date and time for their wedding at least six months in advance. Attendance at a Pre-Cana Conference is also required.

CARE OF THE SICK "Come to me you who are weary..." Please

notify the rectory office for a pastoral visit to any family member who is sick, confined at home, hospitalized or in a nursing home. Arrangements for the reception of sacraments of the Eucharist can be made through the rectory office. Ministers of the sick are available to bring communion to shut-ins on a weekly basis.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the sick is administered each First Thursday after the 7:00 PM Mass and upon request.

Adults interested in the Catholic faith are cordially invited to contact the rectory office for information about Adult Inquiry Classes, the Catechumenate, and preparation for adult reception of the Sacraments of Christian Initiation (RCIA) .

For those who have been asked to be sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation, we gladly issue recommendations for parishioners who: (1) are baptized and confirmed; (2) are at least 16 years old; (3) are registered for at least 6 months; (4) attend Mass regularly; (5) if married, have done so in conformity with the laws of the Church; (6) if they are parents, are sending their children to Catholic School or Religious Instructions; (7) if they are students, are attending Catholic School or Religious Instructions.

“CHRIST THE KING SEMINARY COLLECTION” IS NOW “FORMATION COLLECTION”:

With the timing of the decision to close the Seminary and communication to the giving envelope providers and the distribution schedules planned in advance, the envelopes provided in your mailing for “Christ the King Seminary” will be applied to the diocesan “Formation” operating budget. The “Formation” operating budget consists largely of tuition expenses for seminarians and diaconate candidates. Seminarians from our diocese are pursuing their studies either at St. Mary’s Seminary in Baltimore or, if they are a final year seminarian with a May 2021 ordination date, still at Christ the King (only for this academic year). Diaconate candidates are pursuing their studies through our new collaboration with St. Bernard’s School of Theology in Rochester in a combination of in-person classes and remote learning. The Collection for “Formation” is the weekend of September 26/27.

MARRIED COUPLES: If anything, this year of quarantine has shown us is the importance of marriage and family. Are you and your spouse looking to grow spiritually together? Are you seeking fellowship with other Catholic couples? Teams of Our Lady is a movement of married couples that has been in Western New York for forty years.
