

On the 46th anniversary of the Supreme Court Roe v. Wade decision that gave women the legal right to abortion, New York state passed the Reproductive Health Act (RHA) on January 22 that expands abortion-rights legislation in the Empire State.

The RHA expands the current law to allow late-term abortions when "the fetal viability or the abortion is necessary to protect the patient's life or health." It also allows abortion if it's necessary to save the mother's life or protect her health, and move abortion from the criminal code to the public health code.

NYS is vying to be the most progressive and liberal state in regards to a woman's right to choose- meaning the ability to destroy the life she conceived.
